

P6 Overview, Term 2, 2020

Maths

Addition/Subtraction

This term students will continue to explore addition, subtraction, multiplication and time.

Addition and subtraction with numbers up to three digits and for some four. Use of formal and written methods of columnar addition and subtraction. Creating number patterns using addition and subtraction.

(ACMNA054, ACMNA029)

Multiplication

Skip counting in 2's, 3's, 5's, and 10's.

Groups and arrays into equal sets. (ACMNA31, ACMNA032).

Time

Using calendars to determine the date and identify the days in each month. Name and order each month of the year and, seasons of the year.

Literacy/English

Spelling

Throughout term 2, students will be continuing with their weekly spelling activities, journal writing and English activities. Students have a weekly spelling activity where they practise their spelling words within 5 different groups. These activities include, sentence structure, using their words in a sentence using capital letters and full stops. Alphabetical order, where they have to put either all or 5 of their words into alphabetical order. (Depending whether they are in a group that is learning 6 or more words per week). (ACELA1465)

Reading

- Class novel this term will be Gansta Granny by David Walliams. There are many activities attached to the book which each child participates in according to their ability.(ACELT1596)
- Reader's taken home each night and noted on the Premiers reading Challenge. *(ACELY1659)
- Reading Eggs (ACELA1460)

Written English

Journal writing which is mostly a recount writing activity whereby the students record what they have done the previous day and also what they have done at home. Some of the writing is around specific things e.g. 'My Pet', 'Mum's Birthday Party' etc. Topics change each week. (ACELA1470)

Some students are starting to do some narrative and procedure writing using their developing skills of stories, movies and word knowledge.

History

Australian celebrations. Researching some of the unique celebrations of Australia and some of the ways we celebrate indigenous cultures and other cultural celebrations within Australia. (ACHASSK054, ACHASSKO1075)

Geography

States and Territories of Australia. Researching what makes each state unique and how they all come together as one country. (ACHASS1074)

Computers (ICT)

Students will continue creating PowerPoints, invitations cut and paste across documents using information researched from the net. (ACTOIK007)

Designing and creating documents using text frames, pictures and different types of text. (ACTOIK008)

The Arts

Visual; Using several different mediums to create art pieces. (ACAVAM111)

Performing Arts: Learning about Beta, Tempo, and Rhythm and playing instruments.

(ACAMUM 084, ACAMUM085, ACAMUM087)

Students will continue to practice ball skills using large and small balls. Working in teams to play different games. Electing a leader of the team and taking turns to be the leader. (ACPMP045, ACPMP40, ACPMP50)
